Munnell Run Farm Day

The third annual Munnell Run Farm Day is slated for Sunday, September 16, 2007 from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The purpose of this family-oriented event is to acquaint the community with Munnell Run Farm, the area's rich historical and agricultural heritage, the works of local artisans, the sounds of local musicians, and the season's bounty of locally produced farm products.

New this year is an art exhibit by the Lakes Area Art Guild, a group of local artists whose works include pottery, watercolor paintings, and photography. A number of fine handcrafters will also be on hand to demonstrate and sell their wares which include hand-carved walking sticks, handmade bows, baskets, chainsaw carvings, fiber arts, gourd art, and many other interesting items. A quilt show will also feature local, hand-made quilts.

Several activities will be available for children to enjoy including a farm animal petting pen, horseback riding, fall-themed games and prizes, and, of course, a wagon ride and tour of the farm.

Dennis James of DJ's Greenhouse will give a presentation about fall gardening at 1:00 p.m. and the Doug Butchy Big Band will perform live from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

A variety of food will be available including spit-roasted chicken by the Mercer County Youth Conservation Camp, chili, cornbread, pop, coffee, tea, and funnel cakes by the Shenango River Watchers, ice cream, nachos, and hot dogs by McCullough's Ice Cream, and popcorn and drinks by Munnell Run Farm.

We hope that you will join us on September 16 for a fun-filled day at the farm!

UPCOMING PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

Our summer kids' programs just ended, but we're already looking forward to fall. Our autumn preschool programs will run on four consecutive Wednesday afternoons from September 12 through October 3 from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m. These programs are for children ages 3, 4 and 5, but younger siblings are always welcome. All children must be accompanied by an adult and all programs are by pre-registration only. The fee for the programs is \$2.00 per child and may be paid the day of the visit. AN UN-HAUNTED HAYRIDE

Bring the whole family and join us on Saturday, October 13 anytime between 3:00 and 5:30 p.m. for an UN-Haunted Hayride to learn more about why some of the creatures we think of as "scary" really aren't. Program participants will ride the Munnell Run Farm wagon to our woodlot and walk the forest trail to learn about spiders, bats, and other creatures with a bad rap. The program will last approximately one and a half hours. Other free activities for children will also be available. Fees are \$5.00 for adults, \$2.00 for children, and kids under 3 are free. The proceeds from this fundraiser will help us build restroom facilities.

We will also hold a spit-roasted pork dinner on October 13 from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. In addition to fork tender pork, the menu includes a baked potato, a choice of coleslaw or applesauce, a vegetable, fresh-baked bread, dessert, and a beverage.
