

SUMMERTIME FUN AT THE FARM!

This series of summer programs for kids ages 6 to 9 will be held on consecutive Wednesday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., July 12-August 9, 2006. Please note that pre-registration is required. The fee for each program is \$2.00 per child and may be paid the day of the visit. Children in this age group do not need to be accompanied by an adult, although parents are always welcome. Permission slips are required and must be on file. Sun Fun—July 12, 1:00 p.m. -3:00 p.m.: Today the kids will learn about the sun and have fun in the process! We'll use solar power to cook some hot dogs, learn about sun safety, and even make a "personal UV detection device" to take home.

Soil Sleuths—July 19, 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m.: Participants will investigate the importance of soil by taking a closer look at what it is, how it forms, and why it's necessary for life on Earth. We'll learn the "real dirt" about some of the fascinating "critters" that call the soil "home," and snack on "dirt cupcakes" during this interesting program



Garden Partners—July 26, 1:00p.m.-3:00 p.m.: Children who join us today will learn about bugs, birds, and animals that are GOOD for our gardens. We'll spend some time in our Children's Garden here at the Farm, meet some of the creatures that help our crops in surprising ways, and sample some of the garden's "bounty" they help to provide.

Fun on the Farm—August 2, 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m.: It's the good old summertime and today we'll do the things the kids like best—hunt bugs, go for a ride on our farm wagon, hike in the woods, visit the stream, and make (and eat!) homemade ice cream. Be sure to wear older, comfortable clothes and shoes suitable for walking on rougher ground (sandals aren't recommended).
